

12-core optical cable positive and negative poles



Summary of Content

In a 12-core optical cable, the “positive and negative poles” correspond to the transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx) fibers, which must be correctly mapped to maintain end-to-end signal flow.

Understanding Fiber Polarity

In fiber-optic systems, polarity ensures that the Tx signal from one device reaches the Rx port of the other device. For 12-core MPO/MTP cables, this involves:

- **Fiber Mapping:** Each fiber in the MPO connector is numbered (1-12) and assigned a logical role as Tx or Rx. Correct mapping ensures that data flows in the intended direction .
- **Connector Orientation:** MPO connectors have a key (key-up or key-down) and may be male (with pins) or female (without pins). The key orientation and pin configuration determine how fibers align when mated .
- **Polarity Methods:** There are three standard methods to maintain polarity:
 - **Method A:** Straight-through MPO array cables with Type A adapters (key-up to key-down). Tx fibers connect directly to Rx fibers at the other end.
 - **Method B:** Uses Type B cables and adapters (key-up to key-up) with a fiber flip in the trunk cable, simplifying 12-fiber polarity for duplex links.
 - **Method C:** Cross-over Type C cables flip fiber pairs (Position 1 to 2, 2 to 1, etc.), but this method is complex and not recommended for parallel optics .
