

24-core optical cable arranged in 4 tubes



Summary of Content

A 24-core optical cable is typically organized into 4 tubes, each containing 6 fibers, with standardized color coding and tube numbering for easy identification and splicing.

Fiber Grouping and Tube Layout

In a 24-core optical cable, the fibers are divided into 4 buffer tubes, each holding 6 individual fibers. This multitube design provides protection, organization, and easier handling during installation and maintenance. The tubes are usually stranded around a central strength member (CSM) using an S-Z stranding pattern, which allows the fibers to adjust to tension and thermal changes without damage. Each tube is color-coded for identification, and the fibers inside follow a standard 12-fiber color sequence, repeating as needed.

Color Coding of Fibers

Each fiber within a tube is assigned a distinct color according to the TIA/EIA-598-C standard. For a 6-fiber tube, the typical color sequence is:

- Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate (Gray), White This sequence ensures that each fiber can be easily identified during splicing or troubleshooting. When multiple tubes are used, the tube itself is also color-coded, for example:
- Tube 1: Blue, Tube 2: Orange, Tube 3: Green, Tube 4: Brown This dual-level color coding (tube and fiber) simplifies fiber management in closures and pedestals.
