- Router features, such as QoS (Quality of Service) for prioritizing traffic For heavier usage, dual-band or Wi-Fi 6 routers may offer better performance, but for standard 300Mbps fiber, a single-band N300 router is sufficient.

Connecting Fiber Optic Cable to the Router

To connect your fiber optic internet to a 300Mbps router, follow these steps :

- Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT): This device converts the fiber signal to Ethernet. Your ISP usually provides it.
