

4-core optical fiber cable terminated by fiber optic splitter pigtail

Overview

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, designed for fusion or mechanical splicing to incoming fiber cables in the field . - **Fiber Optic Splitter:** A device that divides an optical signal from one input into multiple outputs, commonly used in FTTH (Fiber to the Home) or PON (Passive Optical Network) deployments.
- **Splitter Pigtail:** A pigtail pre-terminated with connectors on the output side and bare fibers on the input side, designed to be spliced to the incoming fiber cable .
