

48-core optical fiber cable color

This "Tube and Fiber" system ensures that every fiber has a unique color combination.

Tube Colors

For a 48-fiber cable, the tube colors typically follow the first four colors of the TIA-598-C sequence:

- Blue Tube - Fibers 1-12
- Orange Tube - Fibers 13-24
- Green Tube - Fibers 25-36
- Brown Tube - Fibers 37-48

Fiber Colors Within Each Tube

Each fiber inside a tube is colored according to the 12-color sequence:

- Blue
- Orange
