How Switches Connect Fiber Optic Cables

Switches use SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ transceiver modules to interface with fiber optic cables. Each SFP module typically requires two strands of fiber—one for transmitting (TX) and one for receiving (RX)—forming a duplex connection. The type of fiber depends on the distance: multi-mode fiber is used for runs under 1000 feet, while single-mode fiber is preferred for longer distances . Modern SFP modules usually feature LC-style connectors, which are compact and compatible with pre-terminated fiber cables .

Fiber Cable Types and Pre-Termination

Using pre-terminated multi-strand fiber cables simplifies installation. For example, a 4-strand fiber cable contains four individual fibers, each with a protective cladding and connectors already attached. This eliminates the need for on-site termination, reduces labor costs, and ensures low signal loss . Pre-terminated cables can be connected directly to switches via LC-LC couplers or SFP modules, providing reliable, high-speed connections .
