

AP connects to optical module



Summary of Content

An AP connects to an optical module via an SFP/SFP+ port, where the module converts electrical signals from the AP into optical signals for transmission over fiber.

How the Connection Works

An optical module serves as the interface between the AP and the fiber optic network. It performs electrical-to-optical (Tx) and optical-to-electrical (Rx) conversion, allowing the AP to send and receive data over long distances without signal degradation . The module typically contains:

- TOSA (Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts electrical signals from the AP into modulated light using a laser diode or LED .
- ROSA (Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals for the AP .
- PCBA and control circuits: Manage signal processing and maintain stable optical power.
