

Add a capacitor to the distribution box

- **Capacitor Banks:** Multiple capacitors can be grouped into a bank and connected in parallel to the distribution line. This centralizes power factor correction and allows for easier switching or automation.
- **Distributed Capacitors:** For long feeders, capacitors can be placed along the line, often about two-thirds down the feeder, to reduce line losses and maintain a uniform voltage profile.
