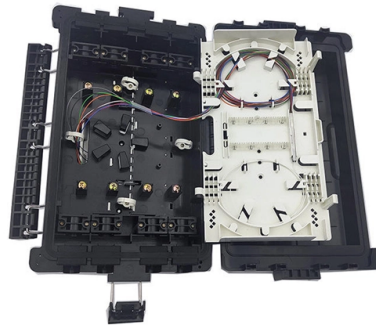


Advantages and disadvantages of ODF fiber optic distribution frames
