

All methods for fiber optic cable suspension installation

Aerial fiber optic cables are typically suspended using messenger strands or self-supporting designs, with careful tensioning, lashing, and hardware fittings to ensure safe, low-stress installation.

Overview of Suspension Methods

Fiber optic cables in aerial applications are generally supported in two ways:

- **Lashed to a Messenger Strand:** A steel wire, known as a messenger or suspension strand, is installed between poles or support structures. The fiber optic cable is then lashed to this strand using a small-gauge wire, maintaining proper tension and sag to withstand the cable's weight and environmental loads such as wind, ice, or snow .
- **Self-Supporting Cables:** Some cables, like All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) or Figure-Eight cables, carry their own messenger. ADSS cables use aramid yarn for strength, eliminating the need for a separate strand, while Figure-Eight cables have a built-in messenger portion to support the optical fibers .

Installation Techniques

Moving Reel Method

- Used when the route is accessible by vehicles.
- The cable is unspooled from a moving reel and simultaneously lashed to the messenger strand.
- Lashing begins at the far end of the run and progresses toward the reel location .
