- Single-mode fiber (SMF): OS1 for indoor, OS2 for outdoor applications. Best for long-distance connections and minimal signal loss .
- Multi-mode fiber (MMF): OM3 and OM4 are recommended for home use when budget allows, offering high-speed performance over shorter distances .
