

Approximately how many millimeters should be left when preparing the pigtail fiber



Overview

Most pigtails have a 900µm buffer and a 250µm acrylate coating. Using your fiber strippers, remove these layers in small, controlled increments. You must be careful to use the correct notch on your stripping tool. Note: In the picture, the fibres are just resting in the FSC24 (Fibre Splice Chip) and are not secure. They can either be coiled up and. Quick answer: A fiber optic pigtail is a short cable with a factory-installed connector on one end and exposed fiber on the other. Instead of building a connector from scratch in the field, you simply fuse the “bare” end of the pigtail to. How many millimeters should you leave at the end of a fiber in preparation to attach an AFL Fujikura FASTConnect connector?

To attach an AFL Fujikura FASTConnect connector, you should leave at least 25 mm of fiber at the end. Multi-fiber pigtails use color-coded individual fibers per the TIA-EIA-598-A color standard, which allows technicians to identify and trace.
