

Are full-duplex LC optical modules divided into left and right sides

Full-duplex LC optical modules are not inherently divided into left and right sides; the left/right designation is a convention used to maintain correct TX/RX polarity in duplex connections.

Duplex LC Connector Design

A duplex LC connector houses two fibers side-by-side in a single assembly, with one fiber dedicated to transmit (TX) and the other to receive (RX) signals, enabling full-duplex communication. Each fiber operates independently, but the duplex clip ensures consistent spacing and alignment, simplifying installation and reducing pairing errors. The connector includes two 1.25 mm ceramic ferrules, a plastic housing, and a latch mechanism for secure mating.

Left/Right Convention

While the connector physically contains two fibers, the left and right sides are not intrinsic to the module itself. Instead, the designation is a polarity convention to ensure that TX on one end connects to RX on the other. Two common polarity types exist:

- Type-A (straight-through): Position 1 on one end connects to position 1 on the other end, maintaining a straight fiber path. Often used in passive FTTH deployments.
