The transformers used in industry and in commercial buildings are generally less than about 1500 kVA in rating, although some may be up to 2500 kVA. Distribution transformers sit at the practical interface between medium-voltage (MV) feeders and utilization voltages, shaping the voltage profile seen by end-use equipment and influencing both technical performance and operating cost.
