- Aramid yarn strength members: Surrounding the tubes, aramid fibers (e.g., Kevlar) provide tensile strength and elongation properties, allowing long spans between towers .
- Central strength member: Some designs use a central FRP (Fiber Reinforced Plastic) rod around which multiple tubes are stranded, enhancing mechanical stability .
