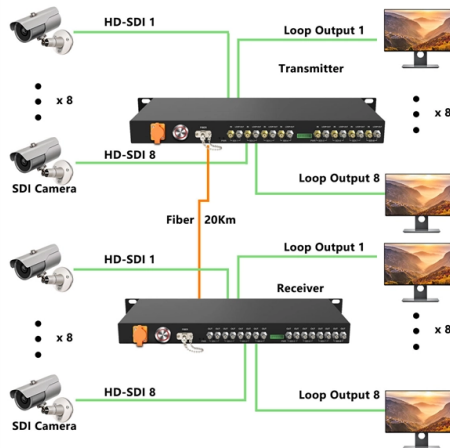


Barbados ONU Spectrum Splitter Parameters

Overview of ONU Spectrum Splitters

ONU (Optical Network Unit) spectrum splitters are passive optical devices used in PON networks to divide a single optical signal from the OLT (Optical Line Terminal) into multiple downstream signals for end users. In Barbados, these splitters are deployed as part of FTTH networks under GPON or EPON standards, coordinated with the Telecommunications Unit and regional spectrum management policies .

Key Parameters

- Splitting Ratio
- Common ratios include 1:2, 1:4, 1:8, 1:16, 1:32, and 1:64, depending on network design and subscriber density.
- The ratio determines how the optical power is divided among multiple ONUs, affecting signal strength and reach.
- Insertion Loss
- Typical insertion loss ranges from 3.5 dB for 1:2 splitters to 17 dB for 1:64 splitters.
- Low insertion loss is critical to maintain sufficient optical power at each ONU, ensuring reliable downstream and upstream communication.
