Overview of Base Station Power Distribution

Base station power systems include both AC and DC distribution units. The AC distribution panel supplies power to AC loads and rectifiers, while the DC distribution unit (DCDU) provides stable -48V DC power to telecom equipment such as RRUs, BBUs, and EMUs . The DCDU ensures uninterrupted operation by distributing power according to load requirements and includes protection mechanisms like overload, undervoltage, and overheat protection .

Current Ratings and Distribution

- Input Voltage: -48V DC
- Maximum Input Current: 160A
- Output Ports: Typically 10 ports per DCDU
- Maximum Output Current per Port: 30A
- Load Allocation: Each port is assigned a maximum fuse current to prevent overload and ensure safe operation . This configuration allows the DCDU to support macro, micro, and distributed base stations, providing reliable power to multiple devices simultaneously.
