

Battery Installation in Distribution Box



Summary of Content

Batteries in a distribution box should be installed on trays with proper spacing, connected from bottom to top, and wired according to manufacturer and safety standards to ensure safe, efficient, and maintainable operation.

Battery Tray and Layout

Batteries should be placed on dedicated trays or supports inside the distribution box, leaving space between layers for ventilation and safe handling. Install trays first, then place batteries onto them, ensuring separators between adjacent batteries to prevent short circuits. For high-capacity batteries (≥ 80 Ah), separators in the depth direction may not be necessary. Batteries should be arranged evenly from front to rear and bottom to top to maintain balance and accessibility for maintenance .

Wiring and Connection

- Bottom-to-top installation: Connect cables starting from the bottom layer and proceed upward to avoid cable strain and ensure proper routing .
- Cable routing: Secure cables vertically along rack rails and horizontally along tray support beams. Avoid sharp bends or excessive tension to prevent terminal damage .
- Pre-charge circuits: Include pre-charge circuitry to limit inrush current when connecting to the DC bus, protecting contactors and batteries .
- Fusing and protection: Each string should have individual fuses (e.g., 160A) and current sensors, with a main breaker sized according to system requirements (e.g., 600–800A for large ESS), .
