

Bus low voltage trip DC



Overview

A low voltage trip occurs when the DC bus voltage drops below the trip point. It is important to note that the VFD does not directly measure input voltage. Reference to the Drive (VFD) undervoltage protection for common low HP drives is based on the measured voltage on the DC bus of the drive unit and not the input AC voltage. Any and all events that could cause a dip in DC bus voltage could lead to a dc. What could cause the DC bus voltage on a drive to drop when the motor is heavily loaded?

Cause for DC bus voltage to drop when the motor is loaded?

In this case, as the speed of the motor increases, and/or as the load on the motor increases, the DC bus voltage is dropping and the motor current is. The VFD control circuit continuously monitor the magnitude and quality of DC bus voltage (DC link voltage or reservoir voltage) and triggers appropriate protective functions when the thresholds are crossed. Some important protective functions derived from DC bus voltage are: Oftentimes when a drive.
