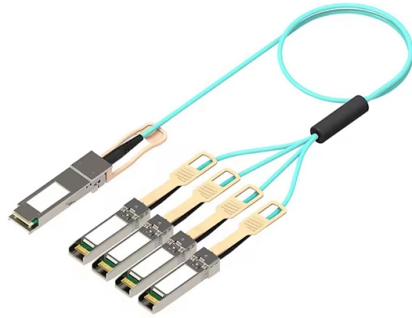

This integration allows for modular expansion, easy maintenance, and improved accessibility to circuits, especially in industrial plants, commercial buildings, and data centers .

- **Low-Voltage Busducts (LV):** Typically used for currents up to several thousand amperes in commercial or industrial applications.
- **Medium-Voltage Busducts (MV):** Designed for higher voltage applications, often in utility or large industrial settings.
