Cable Tray Overview

Cable trays are open or partially open structures used to support and route multiple cables, commonly in industrial, commercial, and data center environments . Types include ladder trays, solid-bottom trays, ventilated troughs, wire mesh, and single rail trays . Ladder trays offer excellent ventilation and are ideal for power cables, while solid-bottom trays provide maximum protection against debris or fluids but limit heat dissipation . Cable trays allow faster installation, easier maintenance, and flexible addition of new cables compared to conduits . They also improve heat dissipation, reducing the risk of cable overheating .

Conduit Overview

Conduits are enclosed tubes—rigid or flexible, metallic or nonmetallic—that fully protect cables from mechanical damage, moisture, chemicals, UV, and electromagnetic interference (EMI) . Common types include rigid metal conduit (RMC), intermediate metal conduit (IMC), and electrical metallic tubing (EMT) . Conduits are preferred in high-risk environments, outdoor installations, underground runs, or areas with heavy equipment where cables need maximum protection . They also provide a longer lifespan and act as a Faraday cage to shield against EMI .
