Cable Management Frames

A cable management frame is a structural component used to organize, secure, and guide cables within a rack or cabinet. Its primary purpose is to prevent tangling, reduce tension on cable connections, and maintain a neat, maintainable wiring system . Cable management frames come in horizontal and vertical configurations:

- Horizontal cable managers provide pathways for patch cords between patch panels and switches, often featuring flexible fingers or covers to protect cables .
- Vertical cable managers are mounted along the sides of racks, supporting proper bend radius and routing multiple cables efficiently . Using cable management frames improves airflow, reduces overheating risks, and simplifies maintenance and upgrades .

Patch Panels

A patch panel is a passive device that serves as a central hub for terminating and connecting network cables. It separates the permanent horizontal/backbone cabling from the flexible patch cord layer, protecting the infrastructure from damage during reconfigurations . Key points include:
