

Cable Tray Industry Standards



Summary of Content

Cable tray systems are governed by international and national standards such as IEC 61537, NEMA VE 1, UL 568, and NFPA 70, which define design, material, load, and installation requirements.

Key Standards

IEC 61537 is the internationally recognized standard for metal and nonmetallic cable tray systems, specifying construction requirements, testing methods, mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, and electrical continuity to ensure safety and performance across various environments. NEMA VE 1 and CSA C22.2 Specification #126.1 cover metal cable trays, including ladder, ventilated, solid-bottom, channel, and wire mesh types. These standards address manufacturing requirements, load/span classifications, shipping, handling, storage, installation, and maintenance, harmonized with the National Electrical Code (NEC) and Canadian Electrical Code (CEC). UL 568 applies to nonmetallic (fiberglass) cable trays, defining construction, performance, and safety requirements for continuous systems used to support power or control cables. NFPA 70 (NEC) provides installation guidelines, including permitted wiring methods, maximum fill areas, and grounding requirements for cable trays. Article 392 specifically addresses cable tray usage, while Article 310 covers conductor ampacities.
