Materials are inspected upon delivery, stored horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports, and protected from moisture and sunlight to prevent corrosion or damage (). Installation routes are marked for horizontal and vertical runs, ensuring adequate clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance (). Supports and hanging systems are carefully designed, often using L-shaped angles and turnbuckle braces, with bolts connecting members to steel frames or slabs (). Pre-installation checks include verifying tools, materials, and safety measures, and ensuring all personnel are trained for working at height ().

Seismic Considerations

Japan's seismic activity necessitates special design for cable tray systems. Large-scale tests conducted by Tokyo Tech and Tongji University evaluated cable trays under simulated earthquake conditions (). Key findings include:

- Seismic-resistant elements are installed at minimum intervals of 12 meters.
