

Cable tray base placement



Summary of Content

Horizontal and Vertical Spacing

When installing cable trays, horizontal spacing between parallel trays should be at least 0.6 meters to allow maintenance access, proper airflow, and prevent cable contact or short circuits . For power and signal trays that may cross, maintain a minimum horizontal separation of 0.5 meters, which can be reduced to 0.3 meters if the trays are shielded to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI), . Vertical spacing for floor-mounted trays should be at least 150 millimeters to prevent obstruction and allow future expansion .

Support and Span Requirements

Cable trays must be supported at intervals specified by the manufacturer, typically not exceeding 5 feet (1.5 meters) for horizontal runs to safely carry the weight of cables and external loads like wind or seismic forces . Ladder-type trays should have rungs spaced no more than 9 inches apart, with a recommended support span of 4 to 6 feet for uniform load distribution . Supports should be level and securely attached to the building structure to prevent sagging and uneven stress on the tray .

Tray Type Considerations

- Ladder trays: Ideal for heavy power cables, providing excellent ventilation and convenient tie points for cable management .
- Ventilated trough trays: Offer continuous support for smaller control or instrumentation cables, reducing sag between rungs .
