Cable tray brackets are designed to support cable trays with specific load capacities, widths, and mounting configurations, typically made from steel or aluminum with standardized dimensions for industrial and commercial applications.

Bracket Types and Mounting

Cable tray brackets are used to support ladder, ventilated, or solid-bottom trays and can be mounted on walls, ceilings, floors, or equipment racks. Common bracket types include:

- Wall-mounted brackets: Extend horizontally to support trays along walls.
- Ceiling-mounted brackets: Suspend trays from overhead structures.

- Depth/Projection: Wall brackets typically project 150 mm to 600 mm from the mounting surface, depending on tray width and load.
