

Cable tray clamp network cable connection method

Planning and Tray Selection

Before installing network cables, plan the tray route carefully, considering clearance, load capacity, and cable separation requirements . Choose the correct tray type—ladder trays allow airflow and easy cable entry, while perforated or solid-bottom trays support lighter loads or protect against interference .

Installing Cable Trays

- **Support Placement:** Position supports so that connectors between tray sections fall between the support point and the quarter-point of the span, avoiding mid-span placement .
- **Mounting:** Use clamps, brackets, or trapeze supports to secure trays to walls, ceilings, or floors. Typical support spacing is 1.5–3 meters depending on tray type and load .
- **Connecting Trays:** Use splice plates, bolted connections, or quick-connect systems to join tray sections. Clamp-based connections are often used for smaller adjustments or securing cables to the tray without additional hardware .
