Planning and Route Design

Tray Selection

- Ladder-type trays: Ideal for heavy cables and allow airflow, reducing heat buildup. Suitable for both internal and external use if corrosion-resistant materials are selected.
- Perforated trays: Support lighter loads and provide ventilation. Common for internal installations.
- Solid-bottom trays: Protect sensitive cables from dust, moisture, or electromagnetic interference, often used indoors or in controlled outdoor environments. Material selection is critical: aluminum offers corrosion resistance and light weight, stainless steel provides high durability for harsh outdoor conditions, and fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) is suitable for highly corrosive environments.
