

Cable tray corner laying treatment

Proper cable tray corner installation uses elbows or angled fittings to maintain cable integrity, ensure mechanical stability, and comply with electrical standards.

Planning and Layout

Before installing a corner, review the approved shop drawings to determine the exact route, angles, and clearance requirements for the cable tray system . Ensure that the corner does not interfere with other services and allows sufficient space for cable pulling and future maintenance . Plan the shortest and straightest path possible to reduce cable stress and simplify maintenance .

Types of Corner Fittings

- Horizontal Elbows: Used for 90° or other horizontal directional changes.
- Vertical Elbows: Used for changes in elevation, either upward or downward.
- T-Junctions and Cross-Junctions: For branching or intersecting tray runs . Select fittings that match the tray type (ladder, perforated, or solid-bottom) and material (galvanized steel, stainless steel, aluminum) to ensure mechanical strength and corrosion resistance .

Installation Best Practices

- Maintain Minimum Bend Radius: Ensure cables are not bent beyond their minimum radius to prevent damage and signal degradation .
- Secure Supports: Install corner fittings on properly spaced supports, typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart, depending on tray type and load .
