

Cable tray installation on a slope

Installing cable trays on a slope requires careful planning of support spacing, slope alignment, and cable management to ensure safety, structural integrity, and code compliance.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, review the approved shop drawings to determine tray layout, slope angles, and lengths of sloped sections (). Ensure all materials, including trays, ladders, fittings, and accessories, are inspected for damage and comply with project specifications (). Store trays horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports to prevent warping or moisture damage ().

Support and Alignment

Cable trays on a slope must be adequately supported to prevent sagging or excessive stress on the tray and cables. Use center-hung supports or wall brackets, ensuring the maximum load per hanger is not exceeded (typically 318–340 kg) and support spacing does not exceed recommended limits, often around 3.6 meters for ladder trays (). For sloped runs, supports should be aligned along the slope to maintain a continuous, stable path for cables.

Slope Considerations

When installing on a slope, calculate the sloped section length using trigonometry or a cable tray offset calculator to determine the correct straight tray length between bends (). This ensures smooth transitions and prevents cable strain. Avoid abrupt changes in slope; gradual inclines reduce stress on cables and facilitate easier cable pulling.
