

Cable tray maintenance height



Overview

Data center cable tray maintenance requires access to overhead infrastructure at heights typically ranging from 3 to 6 meters. This guide compares access equipment.

Cable Types: Only use conductors rated for open-air environments, such as Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables.

Prohibited Areas: Cable trays cannot be. RS cable trays with an edge height of 60 mm are used in widths of 100 to 300 mm. TKS pendant brackets up to a length of 900 mm and TKS 150 to TKS 350 brackets or TKS 100 to TKS 300 brackets with KAWG 12 bracket. covers must be installed to a minimum height of 2. When horizontally installed, the height from the ground should not be lower than 2. Boxes and bags should be stacked onto suitably sized pallets for handling by a fork lift truck.
