

Cable tray manufacturer s elbow installation



Summary of Content

Proper installation of cable tray elbows requires correct support, alignment, and adherence to manufacturer and NEMA VE 2 guidelines to ensure safety and system reliability.

Support and Positioning

Cable tray elbows must be adequately supported to prevent sagging or stress on the cables. Supports should be positioned according to NEMA VE 2 standards, typically near the elbow and at intervals along the tray run to maintain structural integrity and prevent excessive bending of cables . Avoid placing connectors at the center of spans or directly on supports; instead, position them between the support point and the quarter-point of the span . Expansion connectors should be used at building expansion joints and in long outdoor runs, generally every 30 meters (100 feet), to accommodate thermal expansion .

Alignment and Bend Radius

When installing elbows, it is critical to maintain the minimum bend radius for the cables exiting the tray to prevent damage and ensure proper cable performance . The bend radius depends on the cable type and manufacturer specifications. Elbows should be aligned smoothly with the straight sections of the tray to avoid sharp angles that could stress the cables.
