- Tray Type: Ladder, trough, solid bottom, or channel type .
- Material: Aluminum, steel, or stainless steel, sometimes indicated by a letter code (e.g., "G" for galvanized, "P" for painted), .
- Dimensions: Width, depth, and length of the tray section, which are critical for load capacity and installation planning .
- Load Rating or Rung Spacing: Some manufacturers include the rung spacing or load capacity in the part number to ensure compliance with NEMA VE 1 standards . For example, a part number like 156G 09-24-144 may indicate:
- 156G: Material and finish (e.g., galvanized steel)
