

Cable tray sleeve specification deviation



Summary of Content

Cable tray sleeve deviations must be evaluated against project specifications, IEC 61537, and manufacturer tolerances, with any non-conformance documented and approved by the engineer.

Understanding Specification Deviations

A cable tray sleeve specification deviation occurs when the physical dimensions, material, load capacity, or other performance characteristics of a cable tray sleeve differ from the project or manufacturer specifications. Deviations can include differences in width, height, wall thickness, material grade, or coating, which may affect mechanical strength, electrical continuity, and fire resistance .

Standards and Tolerances

- IEC 61537 provides international guidelines for metallic cable tray systems, including construction, load capacity, corrosion resistance, and installation compatibility. Deviations must not compromise these performance parameters .
- NEMA VE 1 and manufacturer-specific standards (e.g., Eaton B-Line, Legrand) define acceptable tolerances for dimensions, load ratings, and material properties .
- Minor deviations within manufacturer-specified tolerances are generally acceptable, but any deviation affecting structural integrity, cable fill ratio, or grounding continuity requires review .

Managing Deviations

- Documentation: Record the deviation in field reports or submittals, including measurements, material certificates, and photographs .
