

Cable tray unloading techniques



Summary of Content

Safe unloading of cable trays and reels involves using forklifts or rolling methods, securing drums properly, and preventing damage to cables and flanges.

General Principles

When unloading cable trays or reels, the primary goal is to prevent physical damage to the cables and the supporting trays while ensuring personnel safety. Cables and trays should be handled by trained personnel using appropriate lifting equipment, and all movements should be controlled to avoid sudden impacts or twisting of the cables .

Forklift Unloading

- Positioning Forks: Insert forklift tynes fully under both flanges of the drum or tray to distribute weight evenly and avoid flange damage .
- Lifting: Gradually lift the drum to a height that allows safe removal from the transport vehicle or container. Avoid lifting by the top flange or the cable itself .
- Transporting: Move the drum slowly, keeping it horizontal and stable. Never push drums sideways with forklift tynes, as this can damage the flanges .
- Lowering: Gently lower the drum onto a firm, level surface, preferably on battens or skids to prevent flange rot or deformation .
