

# Cable trays are allowed to have openings

Cable trays must remain in open, accessible areas to allow for proper maintenance. Grounding: Metallic trays can serve as equipment grounding conductors (EGC) if they meet NEC requirements. Fill Limits: For power cables, the fill must not exceed 40% of the tray's. There is no single global standard for cable tray systems. In practice, the applicable standard depends on three factors: In most international projects, product standards and installation standards are not the same: If you only follow one of them, the system may not pass approval. For these installations, the cable manufacturer's recommended minimum bending. Cable tray is the preferred wiring method for industrial facilities, data centers, and large commercial buildings where routing dozens or hundreds of cables through individual conduits would be impractical and expensive. Their utilization is only possible in environments that have a lot of space to access the wires to carry out repairs.
