Environmental and Material Considerations

When placing trays on the ground, consider moisture, corrosion, and mechanical damage. Aluminum trays should avoid direct contact with bare copper conductors to prevent electrolytic corrosion; insulated conductors are recommended in such cases . Steel trays offer durability but must be properly bonded and grounded. Non-metallic trays are suitable for corrosive environments or where voltage isolation is needed .
