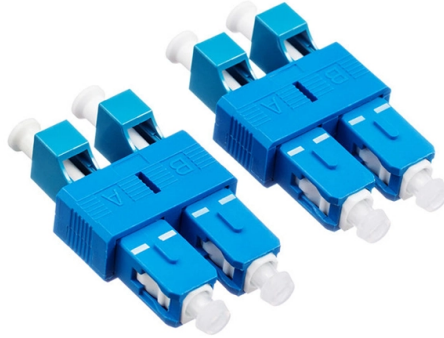


Cables next to the distribution box

Proper Cable Placement and Routing

Label each cable clearly at both ends to indicate its circuit or destination. This simplifies troubleshooting, future upgrades, and maintenance . Consider using color-coded wires for live, neutral, and ground to reduce confusion and improve safety.
