

Calculation of fireproofing and sealing holes for cable trays



Summary of Content

Material calculation for fireproofing cable trays depends on tray size, penetration type, and selected firestop products, including firestop packs, intumescent sealants, and fire-rated foams.

Key Considerations

- Identify the Penetration Type and Size
- Measure the cable tray dimensions and the opening in the wall or slab. For example, a 4" x 12" tray typically requires an opening 1.5" larger on all sides, resulting in a 7" x 15" opening for firestopping purposes .
- Determine whether the penetration is through a concrete wall, gypsum wall, or slab, as fire rating requirements differ (e.g., 3 HR F-rating for concrete, 1-2 HR for gypsum), .
- Select Appropriate Firestop Materials
 - Firestop Packs/Pillows: Medium self-locking pillows (e.g., 3M FSP-SLP-M) are used to fill gaps around cables. The number of pillows depends on the opening size and tray type .
 - Intumescent Sealants: Acrylic or latex-based sealants (e.g., FireStop Intumescent Acrylic Graphite 682) expand under heat to block smoke and fire .
 - Fire-Rated Foams: One-component polyurethane foams (e.g., Fire Rated Gunfoam B1 187) can fill larger voids and adhere to multiple surfaces .
