1 Can you repair a cut fibre optic yourself without a splicer?

Yes, with a mechanical splice (kit available from €5–10 per connector) or by replacing the entire patch cord if it is short and accessible. Fusion splicing gives better results (losses < 0. 1 dB) but requires an arc. While a cut or damaged fiber optic cable can temporarily take your network down, it is possible to quickly fix the cable with the right tools.
