What a Router Does

In contrast, a router is an active network device that manages data traffic between networks. Routers perform functions such as:

- Assigning IP addresses via DHCP
 - Directing packets based on network addresses
 - Managing network security and firewall rules
 - Supporting NAT (Network Address Translation) and routing protocols
- These functions require active processing and power, which a fiber optic splitter does not provide.
