

Can a router be connected to fiber optic internet

Router Compatibility

To use your own router with fiber internet:

- Ensure the router has a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port to connect to the ONT .
- Routers designed for DSL or cable (with phone line or coaxial inputs) will not work .
- For high-speed fiber plans, a Wi-Fi 6 or 6E router is recommended to fully utilize symmetrical upload and download speeds .
- Some routers may be labeled as fiber-ready or GPON compatible, which can simplify setup .

Setup Steps

- Confirm ONT Installation: Make sure your ISP has installed and activated the ONT.
