

Can a router be extended using fiber optic cable

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

To extend your network with fiber optics, you will need:

- Fiber optic cable: Single-mode or multi-mode depending on distance, typically with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts the fiber's light signals into electrical signals your router can use .
- Router: Ensure it supports fiber input or has a WAN port for Ethernet connection from the ONT .
- Media converters (if extending beyond 250 feet or to detached buildings): Convert fiber signals back to Ethernet for standard network devices .
- High-quality Ethernet cables (Cat6a or higher) to connect ONT or media converters to your router or access points .

Step 2: Connect Fiber to the ONT

- Locate the fiber wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters.
