- **Protection:** The trench shields cables from external hazards such as heavy machinery, traffic, or environmental factors, while the tray prevents cables from tangling or resting directly on the trench surface .
- **Material and Design:** Cable trays used in trenches should be made of corrosion-resistant materials like galvanized steel, aluminum, or fiberglass to withstand potential moisture and soil conditions .
- **Code Compliance:** According to NEC guidelines, this setup is generally acceptable, but limitations on cable type, gauge, and fill must be observed as per Articles 390 (underfloor raceways) and 392 (cable trays) for safe installation .
