Types of Buried Optical Cables

They often feature a high-density polyethylene (HDPE) jacket, steel tape or wire armoring, and water-blocking materials to prevent moisture ingress and mechanical damage, making them suitable for long-haul underground routes or areas requiring security and aesthetic concealment. Loose tube cables and ribbon cables are common constructions, with loose tube cables providing flexibility and moisture resistance, while ribbon cables allow high fiber density and mass-fusion splicing for faster installation. Armored cables are preferred in areas with high risk of rodent damage or heavy mechanical stress.
