Overview of Cold Aisle Containment

Cold aisle containment is a data center design strategy where server racks are arranged so that the fronts of the racks face each other, forming a corridor known as the cold aisle. Cold air is delivered into this aisle, typically through raised floor grilles, and servers draw this air into their front intakes. The heated air is then expelled into the adjacent hot aisle, keeping hot and cold air streams separate, which improves cooling efficiency, reduces energy consumption, and extends equipment life .

Design Principles

- **Rack Arrangement:** Cabinets are placed face-to-face in rows to form cold aisles, while the backs of the racks face each other to form hot aisles .
- **Airflow Management:** Cold air is supplied from the floor or in-row cooling units, and hot air is returned to CRAC or PAC units through ceiling ducts or rear-door coolers .
- **Space Optimization:** Proper aisle width and containment panels ensure efficient airflow without obstructing maintenance access .
- **Adaptive Systems:** Modern designs may include adjustable containment panels or ducting to accommodate ceiling height changes and different rack sizes .
