

Color of the first eight cores of the optical cable



Summary of Content

The first eight fibers in a standard optical cable follow the TIA-598 color sequence: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, and Black.

According to the TIA-598-C/D standard, which is widely used for fiber optic identification, each individual fiber within a multi-fiber cable is assigned a specific color to simplify installation, splicing, and maintenance. The first twelve colors in the standard sequence are applied to the fibers in order, and for the first eight cores, the colors are as follows:

- Blue – Fiber 1
- Orange – Fiber 2
- Green – Fiber 3
- Brown – Fiber 4
- Slate (Gray) – Fiber 5
- White – Fiber 6
- Red – Fiber 7
- Black – Fiber 8
