

Common Dimensions of Stainless Steel Cable Trays



Summary of Content

Stainless steel cable trays are available in standard widths from 50mm to 900mm, with heights from 25mm to 150mm and material thickness varying by duty class and application.

Standard Widths and Heights

Stainless steel cable trays are manufactured in ten standard widths: 50mm, 75mm, 100mm, 150mm, 225mm, 300mm, 450mm, 600mm, 750mm, and 900mm . Heights (or sidewall depths) generally range from 25mm to 150mm, depending on cable volume, ventilation requirements, and tray type . Ladder trays often have higher sidewalls for load support, while perforated and wire mesh trays prioritize ventilation and flexibility.

Material Thickness and Duty Classes

Material thickness varies according to the duty class of the tray: light, medium, or heavy duty. Heavy-duty trays typically require 2.5mm or greater thickness with reinforced side rails to support larger power cables and higher loads . Stainless steel grades commonly used are 304 and 316, chosen for corrosion resistance and suitability in harsh environments such as offshore, petrochemical, and food processing facilities .
