Overview

Key Insight: By 2026, Comoros has expanded its fiber optic network to cover 15% of the country, significantly improving internet reliability and speed. Internet penetration has reached 28%, driven by increased mobile broadband adoption and government initiatives to enhance digital. The Union of the Comoros comprises Grande Comore (Ngazidja), Anjouan (Ndzuwani), Mohéli (Mwali) and the Mayotte territory, with island geography that complicates terrestrial network rollout. The FLY-LION3 submarine cable is a 400-kilometer fiber optic system linking Kaweni in Mayotte to Moroni in the Comoros. Commissioned in 2019, according to GeoCables records, it is operated by a consortium comprising Comoros Cables, Orange, and Société Réunionnaise du Radiotéléphone. This is due to the efforts of the government, which has invested in the development of infrastructure and the expansion of internet services.
