Insertion Loss: This measures the reduction of optical power as a signal passes through an adapter. LC adapters typically exhibit 0.1–0.3 dB, SC adapters 0.25–0.5 dB, and MPO adapters 0.2–0.5 dB, depending on fiber count and alignment precision. Lower insertion loss translates to more efficient signal transmission and better network performance.

Return Loss: This indicates the amount of light reflected back to the source. Adapters with APC (angled physical contact) endfaces achieve higher return loss (around -60 dB), reducing reflections and improving signal stability, whereas UPC (ultra-physical contact) endfaces typically reach -30 dB.

Durability: LC and SC adapters generally support 500–1,000 mating cycles, while MPO adapters, due to multi-fiber alignment complexity, support around 500 cycles. High-quality ceramic or metal alignment sleeves enhance longevity and maintain low loss over repeated use.

- **Connector Interface Quality:** Smooth, clean, and precisely manufactured interfaces reduce scattering and reflection, minimizing insertion and return loss.
- **Adapter Material and Structure:** Ceramic, metal, or high-precision plastic sleeves ensure accurate ferrule alignment, critical for low-loss connections.
